Instructions on balancing chemical equations: Enter an equation of a chemical reaction and click 'Balance'. The answer will appear below. Always use the upper case for the first character in the element name and the lower case for the second character. Examples: Fe, Au, Co, Br, C, O, N, F. Compare: Co - cobalt and CO - carbon monoxide. If you also get perplexed in balancing chemical equations, follow the tips for correct balancing chemical equations worksheet answers. Tip # 1: When you are trying to balance the chemical equations, you should remember that you can only change the value of coefficient in front of the element or compound, and not the subscript. Word Equations Write the word equations below as chemical equations and balance: 1) Zinc and lead (II) nitrate react to form zinc nitrate and lead. 2) Aluminum bromide and chlorine gas react to form aluminum chloride and bromine gas. 3) Sodium phosphate and calcium chloride react to form calcium phosphate and sodium chloride., Balancing Chemical Equations Worksheet 1 110.
