China recorded a Government Budget deficit equal to 4.20 percent of the country's Gross Domestic Product in 2018. Government Budget in China averaged -2.20 percent of GDP from 1988 until 2018, reaching an all time high of 0.58 percent of GDP in 2007 and a record low of -4.20 percent of GDP in 2018.
