

Download Order Of Operations Activities

An Operations Order, often abbreviated to OPORD, is a plan format meant to assist subordinate units with the conduct of military operations. An OPORD describes the situation the unit faces, the mission of the unit, and what supporting activities the unit will conduct in order to achieve their commander's desired end state. Let's look at some examples that involve more than two operations. Example 2: Evaluate $3 + 6 \times (5 + 4) \div 3 - 7$ using the order of operations. Solution: Color by number lessons can be a fun change of pace for students and may be used for practice, as a review, as a math center, or as an assignment choice for differentiation of lessons.
