

Download Slavery In America Lesson Plans

The below elementary school lesson plans allow students to learn about the experiences of run-away slaves, as well as a lesson on Thomas Jefferson's contradictory approach to slavery. Criminal or Hero, Runaway or Freeman Grade Level: 5-6 Subject Area: Language Arts, Social Studies Topic: Runaway slaves during the American Revolution. Preview vocabulary, then start the lesson video Slavery in America: Cotton, Slave Trade and the Southern Response. Instruct students to take notes in their chart as the lesson plays. Pause at 2:50 and ask students to provide information to use to fill in the class chart. The lesson begins with an activity that helps students understand the historical record. Students then learn techniques for analyzing primary sources. Finally, students apply these techniques to analyze documents about slavery in the United States. Objectives. Students will be able to: assess the credibility of primary sources; and American Slavery Lesson Plans. This preK-12 lesson and activity curated collection is in response to a Southern Poverty Law Center report, "Teaching Hard History: American Slavery," that shows that schools are failing to teach American Slavery.
