

Download Teaching Tally Marks To First Graders

Teaching Kindergarteners to Make Tally Marks. Children working at the kindergarten level are taught to count a group of objects using tally marks. The objective is that the child will understand that one mark is equal to one object. Also children should be shown how to group tally marks into sets of 5 marks. Teaching tally marks is one of the first things I do to kick-off the new math curriculum. Why teach tally marks at the beginning of first grade? -Practice counting Tally Marks and Tally Charts. For example, with the Tally Dice Roll, you can differentiate by simply giving a different set of directions to different groups. For this center, kids roll the dice then draw the tallies. For your on level and above kids, have them roll 2 dice and use that to create a 2 digit number. Some students may forget to count the diagonal line in a graph of 5 tally marks. I make sure they understand that tally marks are organized in groups of 5. A group of 5 is made by drawing four vertical lines, and then a fifth line is drawn through the first four. I write tally marks for the numbers 1 to 10 on the board., Teaching Tally Marks To First Graders.

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
