Dividends and divisors are the two key ingredients that yield the quotient, or answer, to a division problem. The dividend is the number being divided, while the divisor is the number by which the dividend is divided. In other words, given $a \div b$, a is the dividend and b is the divisor. A divisor is (arithmetic) a number or expression that another is to be divided by while dividend is (arithmetic) a number or expression that is to be divided by another. Divide, division, dividend, divisor. • to divide or division is sharing or grouping. a number into equal parts. • dividend: the number being divided. • divisor or factor: a number that will divide the dividend exactly. Divisor is the denominator of a fraction, normal is written below the “divider bar” / division sign.
