To learn how to turn a four-point rubric into a letter grade, use the basic writing rubric below as an example. The four-point rubric uses four potential points the student can earn for each area, such as 1) strong, 2) developing, 3) emerging, and 4) beginning. The grade 2 rubric has not changed. Grade 3 has a new writing rubrics aligned to writing standard W.RBPK.8. The content of the rubrics has largely remained the same in grades 4 through high school with some language revised for clarity. Perhaps the largest revision is found in the sequencing of the four traits., Writing Rubric For 8th Grade.
